The latest rules from the government

In England

On 22nd February Boris Johnson announced his so-called Road Map for ending Covid restrictions in England.

There are provisional dates for a step-by-step approach, depending on the infection rates, beginning with schools and colleges reopening on March 8th <https://www.bbc.co.uk/news/uk-56158405>

Until then, **The National Lockdown 'Tier Five'** introduced in early January **continues**. The details of the rules and exemptions are here: <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/national-lockdown-stay-at-home> In summary:

- ! You must not leave, or be outside of your home except where necessary. You may leave home to: **shop** for basic necessities, for yourself or for a vulnerable person; **go to work**, or provide voluntary or charitable services, if you cannot reasonably do so from home; **exercise** in a public outdoor space, with your household (or support bubble) or one other person; this should be limited to once per day, and you should not travel outside your local area; meet your **support bubble** or childcare bubble if necessary; seek **medical assistance** or to avoid risk of harm (including domestic abuse); attend **education or childcare** - for those eligible; attend a **place of worship**.
- ! **Schools and colleges** are closed (except for vulnerable children and the children of key workers). They are all scheduled to reopen on 8th March. Nursery schools remain open.
- ! **No socialising**. You cannot meet other people indoors unless you live with them or they are part of your support bubble. Outdoors, you can only meet one person from another household for exercise.
- ! You cannot leave your home or the place where you are living for holidays or overnight stays unless you have a reasonable excuse for doing so. This means that **holidays** in the UK and abroad are currently **not allowed**. This includes staying in a second home or caravan..
- ! **Only 'essential' retail outlets** can remain open. These include food shops, pharmacies, pet shops, garden centres and building suppliers. You must wear a face mask in shops and on public transport. The government has set 12th April as the target for all shops and hairdressers to reopen.
- ! **Pubs and restaurants remain closed** except for takeaways and deliveries. May 17th is the provision date for reopening.
- ! **Entertainment venues** and tourist venues including museums are closed.
- ! **Hotels** and guest houses are closed.
- ! All indoor and outdoor **sports facilities** such as gyms and golf courses are closed.
- ! You can attend **places of worship** for a service. You should maintain strict social distancing at all times. No more than 6 people at a wedding and 30 people for a funeral.

In Warwick

- ! **Vaccinations:** The vaccination centre for the Primary Care Network (PCN) covering Warwick is at Warwickshire Golf Club. Some GP surgeries are also carrying out vaccinations. There is another nearby vaccination centre at Stoneleigh Nat. Agricultural Centre. All over 70s should have received an offer of their first jab by mid-February. - ! **Museums, the Lord Leycester and the County Record Office** are closed to the public. With most people homeschooling, Heritage Warwickshire has been providing some activities children can do from home:
